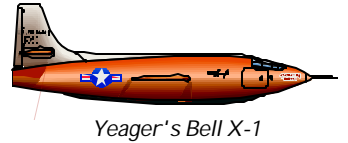


SOMETHING'S WRONG

The *information* in the sentences below is correct, but can you find the mistakes in grammar, punctuation, and sentence structure? Rewrite each sentence correctly.

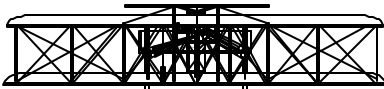
1. Chuck Yeager flew the first supersonic flight, in 1947.
